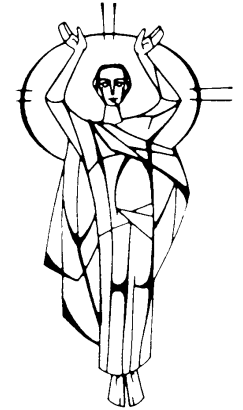

The Resurrection of Our Lord

April 1, 2024

Easter is the most important festival in the Christian calendar. We celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ, after his crucifixion on Good Friday. Christ's death and resurrection are the centre of the Christian faith. And because it's so important, Easter is celebrated not just on one day, but for 50 days – until Pentecost!

Today's lessons:

In the service today, you might hear other readings than the ones here; but whatever is read— all the lessons today are connected with the Gospel of the resurrection of Jesus Christ, and what this means for us.

Acts 10:34-43

The apostle Peter gives a short sermon that summarizes the Christian faith, centred on Jesus' resurrection.

Psalms 118:1-2, 14-24

God has shown us mercy and has saved us from death.

1 Corinthians 15:1-11

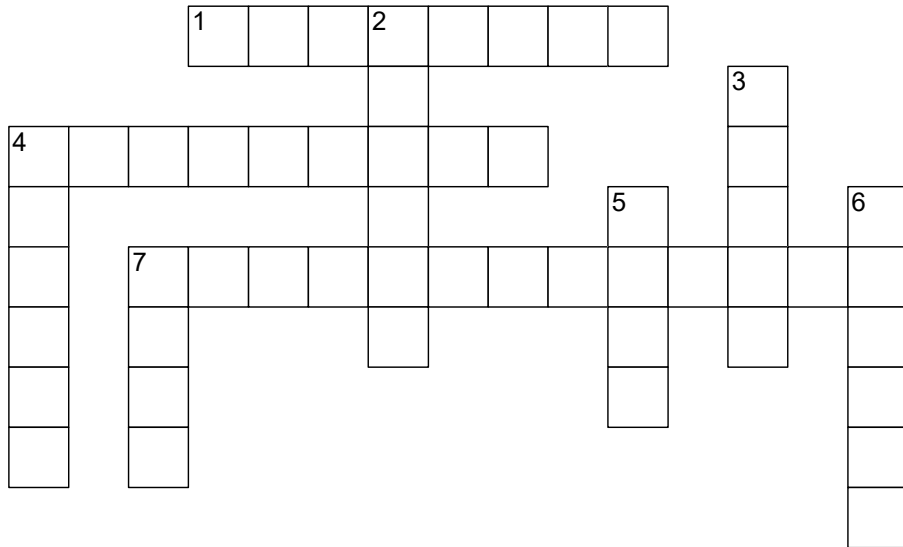
The apostle Paul reminds the Corinthians of the essence of the Creed: that Jesus Christ died for our sins, was buried and was raised from the dead.

Mark 16:1-8

On Easter morning, some women come to Jesus' tomb and want to embalm the corpse. But not only is the stone that secured the entrance gone, there is also a stranger sitting in the tomb, and the body of Jesus has disappeared. So the women run, and don't deliver the message from the stranger: 'You will see him in Galilee.'

Witnesses wanted

Nobody witnessed the resurrection itself. But the Bible names quite a number of people had an encounter with the Risen Christ and went on to tell others about him.

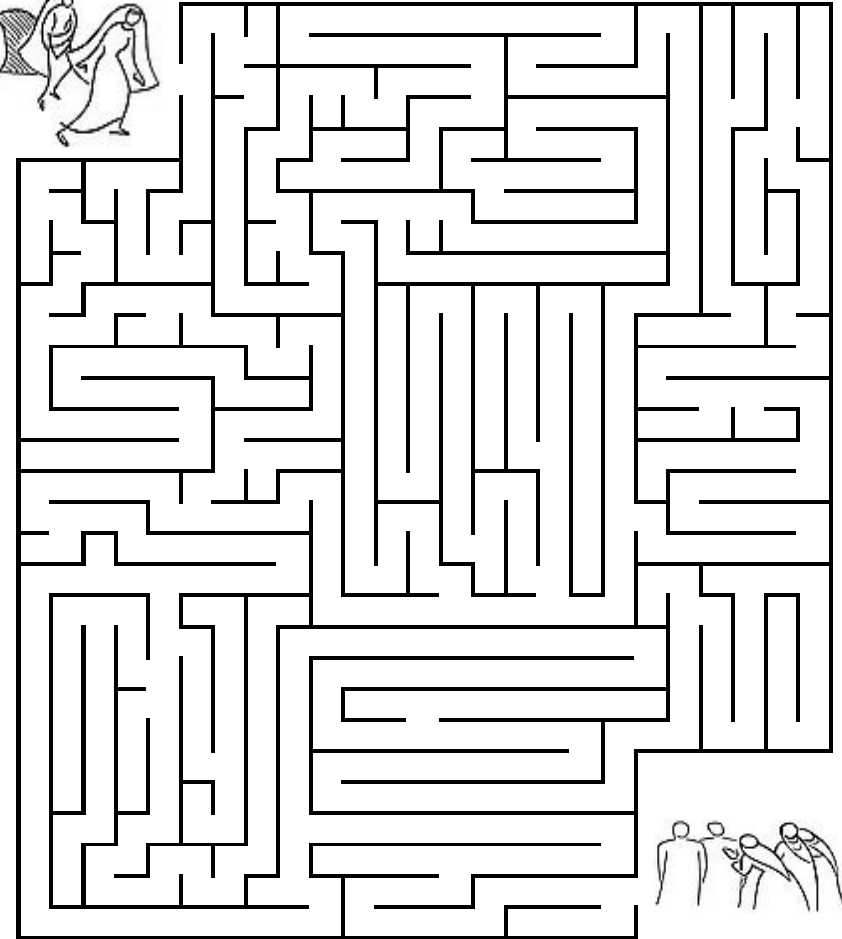
